

M.A. (Program B) Social Studies—(38 s.h. minimum)

The M.A. (Program B) degree is designed primarily for those who decide that they would like to become teachers and have already completed a B.S. or B.A. in an area of social science or history. It features advanced work in the social studies content areas along with the courses required for licensure. It is a means by which candidates can attain a Master’s degree and certification at the same time. This degree assumes the candidate has completed considerable work in the social sciences and/or history as an undergraduate, but little or no previous course work in education.

For licensure purposes, students admitted must have completed or complete 30 semester hours in a history/social science area. This may include previous undergraduate and/or any graduate level course work. Any of the required professional education course work not completed as part of the baccalaureate degree must be completed for licensure.

Fifteen semester hours must be completed for an additional history/social science licensure area. Previous undergraduate course work may apply.
