

TEP Transition to Course-Based Assessments on Tk20 Anticipated Timeline

Spring 2018

Tech in the Classroom along with two other courses test the process.

- Students upload designated course-based assessment assignments to Tk20 servers (test courses).
- Instructors will evaluate student assignments using InTASC/State of Iowa standards rubrics located on Tk20 site test courses.
- Process assessed.

Summer 2018

- Faculty (by program area) revisit-revise-reduce course-based assessment assignments to be evaluated on Tk20.

Fall 2018

- Jean works with faculty (by program area) to prepare Tk20 for course-based assessment assignments.
- Faculty introduced to InTASC/State of Iowa standards rubrics located on Tk20 site.
- Students in Tech in the Classroom (new students) upload to Tk20 servers; they do **not** download ePortfolio templates.
- Faculty do not evaluate ePortfolios; current students not required to maintain one.
- Selected programs (Social Studies & English) will pilot course-based assessment via the Tk20 performance assessment system.

Spring 2019

Full Tk20 implementation of Course-Based Assessments

- All TEP students upload course-based assessment assignments associated with their respective program area to Tk20 server.
- Faculty score student assignments using InTASC/State of Iowa standards rubrics located on Tk20 site.
- Process assessed.

Summer 2020

- Two years after last cohort group of students with ePortfolios graduate, ePortfolio editing (FTP) turned off.

Spring 2021

- ePortfolios are archived.
- ePortfolio server retired.
