Licensed teachers should [contact English Education faculty](#) for a transcript analysis to determine which requirements have been satisfied with previous courses. A typical teacher who holds endorsement number 120, 5-12 English Language Arts and a bachelor's degree in English may need to complete as few as two courses: EDTL:4392 Voice, Drama and Debate in the Secondary Schools and EDTL:4393 Critical Media Studies and Production in Secondary Schools.
