Supervision of student must be under an experienced School Social Work practitioner/Licensed Social Worker to include experiences in assessment; direct services to children and families; consultation; staffing, community liaison and documentation; which leads to development of professional identity and disciplined use of self.
- If a person has served two years as a school social worker, the practicum experience can be waived. This experience must be documented when application for licensure is submitted.
